



**EXPERIENCE** Tanzania's most famous and diverse National Parks – from dense jungles to the endless expanse of the Serengeti plains.


**EXPLORE** Ngorongoro Crater on an early morning game drive, home to Africa's densest lion population and some of the last black rhinos in the world.

**SAVOR** delicious meals at our lodges, and picnic lunches in picturesque locations such as under massive Baobab trees.





## TOUR ITINERARY



## Day One

After arriving in Tanzania, your guide will pick you up at the Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) and bring you to the lodge. Surrounded by beautiful trees and velvet monkeys, this lodge is a secluded and relaxing place to begin our East African journey.

## Day Two

After breakfast today we depart for Arusha National Park. This park has amazing colobus monkey viewing, and giraffes, buffalos, hippos, hyenas, and zebras can all be seen around the lakes and craters.

A real highlight of this park is the opportunity for a guided ranger hike followed by a picnic overlooking amazing landscapes and wildlife. We'll take a lovely afternoon game-drive before returning to the lodge.

## Day Three

After breakfast we'll head north towards Mt. Kilimanjaro and into the rarely-visited Eduimet Wildlife Management Area. While only 290 square miles, Eduimet is a unique community-driven conservation area managed by the Maasai who also calls this place home. We'll meet one of the local conservationists who'll share how this place came to be and how it's managed.

As we'll see, wildlife roams freely and coexists with the pastoral Maasai who graze their cows, sheep, and goats. The area is an important elephant migration path on their way to and from Kenya's Amboseli National Park.

We'll visit a Maasai *boma*, a family compound made up of huts for the patriarch and each of his wives. You'll have an opportunity see the inside of a hut, participate in a traditional dance, and check out their handicrafts.

Following a fresh and filling bush lunch you can either go on a short, guided walking safari escorted by a ranger or stay with the vehicles for a game drive.

We'll drive back to the lodge in Arusha for dinner and a quiet evening.

## Day Four

We'll check out of the lodge today and drive southwest to Tarangire National Park, a hidden gem of Tanzania. The landscape is gorgeous and sightings of zebras, wildebeest, antelopes, and lions are very common amongst the park's iconic baobab trees. Tarangire is also known for some of the greatest concentrations of elephants in the world.

We'll enjoy a game drive and stop at a scenic spot for a picnic. When the sun gets lower in the sky we'll check in at a deluxe tented camp situated inside the National Park, sit down for dinner, and fall asleep in a comfortable bed.

## Day Five

We'll start the day off with a morning game drive in Tarangire National Park. There's usually a lot of activity during morning hours when the light is golden and the heat of the day has yet to set in.

We'll leave the park and drive towards Ngorongoro Conservation Area, stopping for lunch along the way. Once we're past the gate, a series of unpaved switchbacks take us up to the crater rim. We'll stay at a tented lodge near the rim tonight.



## Day Six

We'll get an early start and head down into the Ngorongoro Crater for morning game drive. The crater measures 100 square miles and is the world's largest unbroken caldera. Today it's home to the critically endangered black rhinoceros, as well as one of the densest lion populations in Africa. Other animals to look out for are hippos, zebras, elephants, wildebeest, and more!

We spend the afternoon driving to the famous Serengeti National Park, deep into the heart of wild Africa.

## Day Seven

With over 5,600 square miles of land, every day spent in the Serengeti will bring new landscapes and wildlife into focus.

Depending on the timing, you may get a chance to watch the unfolding of a year-long migration filled with danger and drama.

Watch as hundreds of thousands of wildebeests, zebras, and gazelles make their annual 500 mile journey, while lions and cheetahs pursue and crocodiles wait for a chance to prey.

## Serena Mountain Village

### Nights 1, 2, 3 & 9

Located about 45 minutes from Kilimanjaro Airport on the outskirts of Arusha. This delightful lodge is the ideal base for our Safari and activities in the surrounding area. The rooms are spacious and include a small outdoor area nestled next to the garden chalets. The main building is a former colonial manor in what used to be a coffee plantation. Today you'll find the restaurant, bar, reception, and a small gift shop. Just outside is a garden sitting area with views of Lake Duluti below.

## Balloon Camp Tarangire

### Night 4

Situated in the heart of Tarangire National Park and overseeing Tarangire River, this bush camp offers convenience, comfort, and immediate access to the incredible scenery and wildlife. Each deluxe safari tent features an ensuite bathroom with a shower, vanity, and flush toilets. The common area includes a lounge, dining room, and a small swimming pool, while friendly staff and chefs keep us comfortable, happy, and well-fed.



## Ang'ata Ngorongoro Camp Nights 5

This bush camp is the perfect stop before we head into the Ngorongoro Crater. Enjoy a nice hot shower, sit by the cozy campfire, and eat a great meal. The setting is beautifully rustic and secluded, while the environment is peaceful. Caring and helpful staff offer "bush babies" (hot water bottles to keep you warm in bed) to guests on chilly nights and upon request. The lodge's location is ideal as we will be among the first to descend into the crater at sunrise, which is teeming with wildlife.

## Ang'ata Migration Ndutu Camp Nights 6, 7, 8

The Ndutu Camp is a classic tented safari camp located in the southern part of Serengeti National Park. This is a seasonal bush camp discretely set above a marsh, which allows safe observation of wildlife just below the camp, as well as of Lake Ndutu in a distance.

This location is ideal to experience the Great Wildebeest Migration in full swing and you can expect the same standard, Tanzanian hospitality, and comfort as we've gotten used to from the other camps..



## Our Guides

We work with a carefully selected crew of expert guides. Our guides are from Tanzania and are trained experts of the region's geography, natural history, flora, fauna, and Maasai culture, history, and customs. All of our guides are personable, professional, courteous, friendly, and excited to show our guests some of the most incredible parts of Tanzania. All of our guides are vetted, trained, and hold relevant certifications to guide in Tanzania and inside its beautiful National Parks.

We typically assign guides to specific departure dates a few months out and you'll receive more information about your specific guide or guides before you travel.

# FAQ - GETTING THERE AND BACK

## **Is This Trip For Me?**

- Our Great Migration Safari requires moderate mobility and physical fitness. You should be able to walk unassisted on uneven terrain without established trails for at least three miles, walk with moderate elevation gains to 100 feet (30 meters), and comfortably enter and exit vans, buses, and small aircraft without assistance. You will spend a significant amount of time in our safari vehicles on bumpy roads and across grasslands during game drives, which can last up to five hours, so you should be comfortable sitting for long periods of time. The itinerary includes a scenic flight using a safe, but small aircraft.

## **When should I arrive in Tanzania?**

- You can arrive anytime at the Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) on Day 1 of this itinerary.

## **What do I need to do to prepare for my arrival and journey?**

- Send us your flight itinerary and we will organize an airport pick-up for you (included). A Gondwana Ecotours representative will be waiting for you at the airport with a sign with your name on it or the Gondwana Ecotours logo. Make sure you travel with a valid passport (must be valid for at least six months after your stay) and your visa will be issued upon arrival in Tanzania if you did not secure it ahead of time.

## **What if I want to come and explore before Day 1?**

- If you decide to come before Day 1 we can book a room for you at our first lodge and we will of course organize transportation from the airport to the lodge when you land.

## **What should I do in preparation for my departure?**

- You can depart at the Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) anytime on Day 10 of your Safari. Most guests depart in the afternoon.

- Secure your spots with a \$500 per person deposit (via phone, email, or on our [website](#)) that is fully refundable within 30 days of payment, provided your trip starts at least 121 days from the time of booking.
